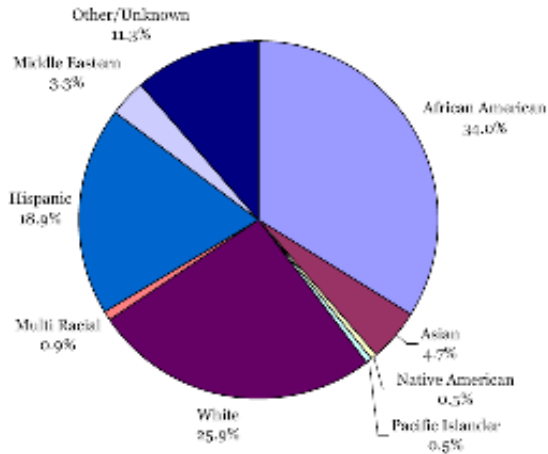




HELPLINE

BHNV provided emergency and crisis intervention assistance in response to 212 helpline calls. 212 adults and 272 children were assisted during this fiscal year.

Race and Ethnic Groups Served

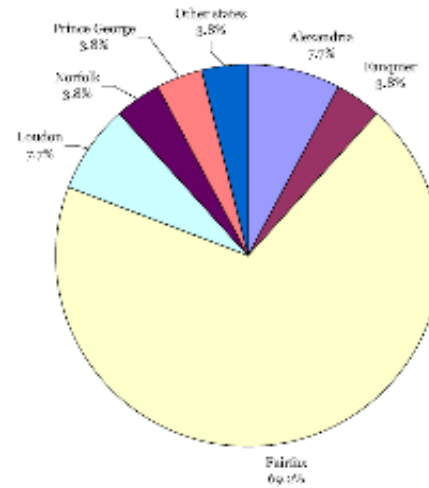


SHELTER AND INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAMS

26 adults and 37 children in need of emergency shelter were taken to a BHNV shelter. These clients received food, clothing and emergency services such as case management, referrals for professional services, transportation, and financial assistance.

4 adults and 3 children received assistance through BHNV's Independent Living Program, providing them with stable housing.

SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES

- 15 adults and 22 children participated in life skills activities.
- 20 adults and 27 children received group counseling.
- 20 adults received individual counseling.
- 2 clients received assistance for car repairs and other auto expenses.
- 11 households (out of 14 exiting the program) moved to a stable housing arrangement.
