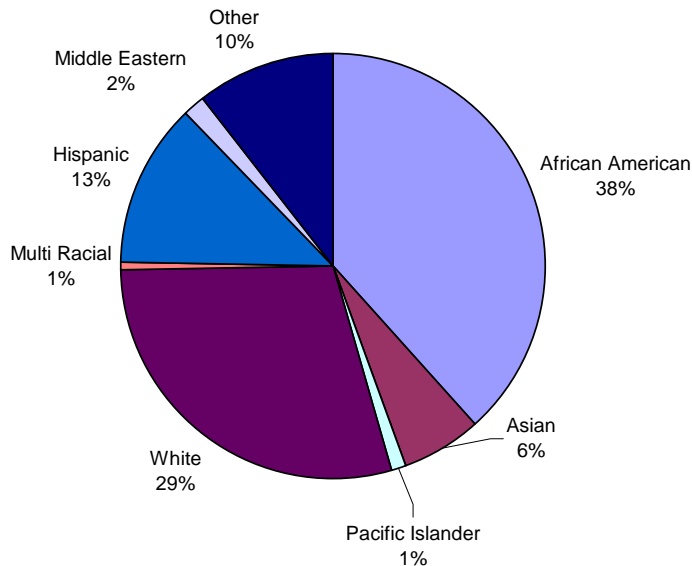


Bethany House of Northern Virginia, Inc. FY 2007-2008

HOTLINE

Bethany House provided emergency and crisis intervention assistance in response to 265 hotline calls. 265 adults and 310 children were assisted during this fiscal year.

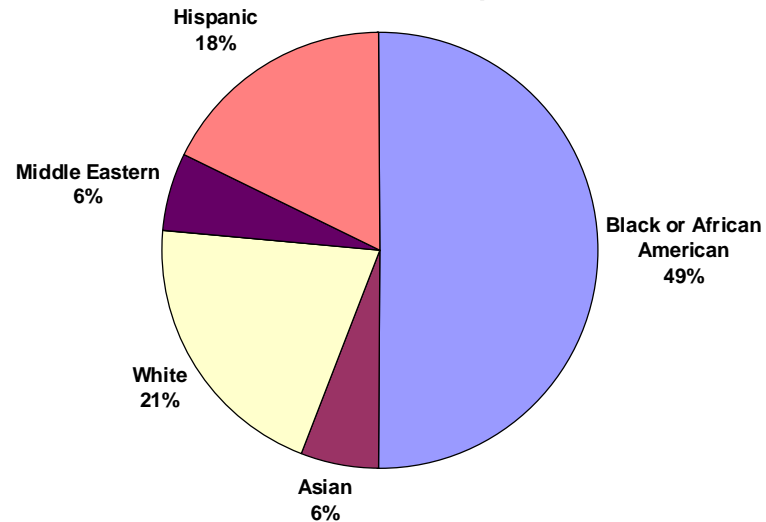


SHELTER AND INDEPENDENT LIVING PROGRAMS

29 adults and 43 children in need of emergency shelter were taken to a BHNV shelter. These clients received food, clothing and emergency services such as case management services, referrals for professional services, transportation, and financial assistance as needed.

9 adults and 1 child received assistance through Bethany House's Independent Living program providing them with a long-term, stable housing.

Race and Ethnic Groups Served



Summary of Outcomes:

- 35 families received continue follow-up support that ensures self –sufficient living among those who have moved out of BHNV Shelters.
- 30 families that participated in domestic violence programs other than BHNV received emergency support through BHNV thrift shop and pantry.
- 4 families transitioned into collaborative Transitional Housing programs. (An additional 14 families moved into their own homes and bypassed the Transitional Housing programs.)
- 48 Parents & children received counseling to overcome the emotional trauma that accompanies domestic violence and abuse.
- 33 families gained basic skills in household financial management, and learned to live independently according to budgeted incomes.
- Bethany House provided 6,549 bed nights for 29 families through its Shelter Program and 1,718 bed nights through the Independent Living Program.
